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- 1. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. - 9. 10. Inspection of Stores by Nominated Inspection Authority / Agency of buyer or their authorized representatives

An independent third party Professional Inspection Body can help buyer in mitigating buyer's risk with predispatch/post-dispatch inspection in order to ensure that equipment, components, solutions and documentation conform to contractual requirements. The buyer has a right to inspect goods in reasonable manner and within reasonable time at any reasonable place as indicated in contract. Inspection Fee/ Charges (as pre-greed between buyer and Inspection Agency) would be borne by the buyer as per their internal arrangement but may be recovered from the seller if the consignment failed to conform to contractual specification and got rejected by the Inspection Officer .If so requested and accepted by the seller , initially seller may pay for inspection charges as applicable and get the same reimbursed from buyer if consignment accepted by the Inspecting Officer . For reimbursement seller has to submit proof of payment to Inspection Agency.

Seller/OEM shall send a notice in writing / e-mail to the Inspecting officer / inspection agency specifying the place

of inspection as per contract and the Inspecting officer shall on receipt of such notice notify to the seller the date and time when the stores would be inspected. The seller shall, at his own expenses, afford to the Inspecting officer, all reasonable facilities as may be necessary for satisfying himself that the stores are being and or have been manufactured in accordance with the technical particulars governing the supply. The decision of the purchaser representative /inspection authority regarding acceptance / rejection of consignment shall be final and binding on the seller.

The Seller shall provide, without any extra charge, all materials, tools, labour and assistance of every kind which the Inspecting officer may demand of him for any test, and examination, other than special or independent test, which he shall require to be made on the seller's premises and the seller shall bear and pay all costs attendant thereon.

The seller shall also provide and deliver store / sample from consignment under inspection free of charge at any such place other than his premises as the Inspecting officer may specify for acceptance tests for which seller/OEM does not have the facilities or for special/ independent tests.

In the event of rejection of stores or any part thereof by the Inspecting officer basis testing outside owing to lack of test facility at sellers premises, the seller shall, on demand, pay to the buyer the costs incurred in the inspection and/or test. Cost of test shall be assessed at the rate charged by the Laboratory to private persons for similar work.

Inspector shall have the right to put all the stores or materials forming part of the same or any part thereof to such tests as he may like fit and proper as per QAP/governing specification. The seller shall not be entitled to object on any ground whatsoever to the method of testing adopted by the Inspecting officer.

Unless otherwise provided for in the contract, the quantity of the stores or materials expended in test will be borne by seller.

Inspecting officer is the Final Authority to Certify Performance / accept the consignment. The Inspecting officer's decision as regards the rejection shall be final and binding on the seller.

The seller shall if so required at his own expense shall mark or permit the Inspecting officer to mark all the approved stores with a recognised Government or purchaser's mark.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Generic

Bidder financial standing: The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

3. Generic

Bidders shall quote only those products (Part of Service delivery) in the bid which are not obsolete in the market and has at least 7 years residual market life i.e. the offered product shall not be declared end-of-life by the OEM before this period.

4. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

5. Generic

End User Certificate: Wherever Bidders are insisting for End User Certificate from the Buyer, same shall be provided in Buyer's standard format only.

6. Generic

7. Generic

PRE- CONTRACT INTEGRITY PACT

1. **GENERAL**

- 1.2. Whereas the Bidder is a private company/public company/partnership/ re gistered export agency, constituted in accordance with the relevant law in the matter and the Buyer is a Ministry of the Government of India perform ing its functions on behalf of the President of India.

2. OBJECTIVES

- 2.1. Now, therefore, the Buyer and the Bidder agree to enter into this pre-cont ract agreement, hereinafter referred to as Integrity Pact, to avoid all form s of corruption by following a system that is fair, transparent and free fro m any influence/ unprejudiced dealing prior to, during and subsequent to the currency of the contract to be entered into with a view to:-
 - 2.1.1. Enabling the Buyer to obtain the desired defence stores at a comp etitive price in conformity with the defined specifications of the Serv ices by avoiding the high cost and the distortionary impact of corrup tion on public procurement, and
 - 2.1.2. Enabling bidders to abstain from bribing or any corrupt practice in order to secure the contract by providing assurance to them that th eir competitors will also refrain from bribing and other corrupt pract ices and the Buyer will commit to prevent corruption, in any form, by their officials by following transparent procedures.

3. COMMITMENTS OF THE BUYER

- 3.1. The Buyer commits itself to the following:-
 - 3.1.1. The Buyer undertake that no official of the Buyer, connected directly

y or indirectly with the contract, will demand, take a promise for or a ccept, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, consideration, gif t, reward, favour or any material or immaterial benefit or any other a dvantage from the Bidder, either for themselves or for any person, or ganisation or third party related to the contract in exchange for an ad vantage in the bidding process, bid evaluation, contracting or implem entation process related to the Contract.

- 3.1.2. The Buyer will, during the pre-contract stage, treat all Bidders alike, and will provide to all Bidders the same information and will not provi de any such information to any particular Bidder which could afford a n advantage to that particular Bidder in comparison to other Bidders.
- 3.1.3. All the officials of the Buyer will report the appropriate Government office any attempted or completed breaches of the above commitme nts as well as any substantial suspicion of such a breach.
- 3.2. In case of any such proceeding misconduct on the part of such official (s) is reported by the Bidder to the Buyer with full and verifiable facts and the sa me is prima facie found to be correct by the Buyer, necessary disciplinary pr oceedings, or any other action as deemed fit, including criminal proceedings may be initiated by the Buyer and as such a person shall be debarred from f urther dealings related to the contract process. In such a case while an enq uiry is being conducted by the Buyer the proceedings under the contract wo uld not be stalled.

4. COMMITMENTS OF BIDDER

The Bidder commits himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corrupt practices, unfair means and illegal activities during any stage of his bid or during any pre-contract or post contract stage in order to secure the contract or in furtherance to secure it and in particular commits himself to the following:-

- 4.1. The Bidder will not offer, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, gi ft, consideration, reward, favour, any material or immaterial benefit or ot her advantage, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any official of the Buyer, connected directly or indirectly with the bidding pro cess, or to any person, organization or third party related to the contract in exchange for any advantage in the bidding, evaluation, contracting an d implementation of the Contract.
- 4.2. The Bidder further undertakes that he has not given, offered or promise d to give, directly or indirectly any bribe, gift, consideration, reward, favo ur, any material or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, f ees, brokerage or inducement to any official of the Buyer or otherwise in procuring the Contract or forbearing to do or having done any act in relat ion to the obtaining or execution of the Contract or any other contract wi th the Government for showing or forbearing to show favour or disfavour to any person relation to the Contract or any other Contract with the Government.
- 4.3. The Bidder will not collude or enter into any undisclosed agreement or u nderstanding with other bidders with respect to prices, specifications, ce rtifications, subsidiary contract etc to impair the transparency, fairness a nd progress of the bidding process, bid evaluation, contracting and imple mentation of the contract.

- 4.4. The Bidder will not accept any advantage in exchange for any corrupt practice, unfair means and illegal activities.
- 4.5. The Bidder further confirms and declares to the Buyer that the Bidder is the original manufacturer/integrator/authorized government sponsored export entity of the defence stores and has not engaged any individual or firm or company whether Indian or foreign to intercede, facilitate or in any way to recommend to the Buyer or any of its functionaries, whether off icially or unofficially to the award of the contract to the Bidder, nor has a ny amount been paid, promised or intended to be paid to any such individual, firm or company in respect of any such intercession, facilitation or recommendation.
- 4.6. The Bidder, either while presenting the bid or during pre-contract negoti ations or before signing the contract, shall disclose any payments he has made, is committed to or intends to make to officials of the Buyer or their family members, agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the contract and the details of services agreed upon for such payments.
- 4.7. The Bidder shall not use improperly, for purposes of competition or pers onal gain, or pass on to others, any information provided by the Buyer as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained in any electronic data carrier to others and not to commit any offence under PC/IPC Act. The Bidder also undertakes to exercise due and adequate care lest any such in formation is divulged.
- 4.8. The Bidder commits to refrain from giving any complaint directly or through any other manner without supporting it will full and verifiable facts.
- 4.9. The Bidder shall not instigate or cause to instigate any third person to commit any of the actions mentioned above.
- 4.10. Foreign bidders to disclose the name and address of agents and representatives in India and Indian Bidders to disclose their foreign principals or associates.
- 4.11. Bidders will disclose the payments to be made by them to agents/broke rs or any other intermediary.
- 4.12. The bidder shall not approach the courts while representing the matters to IEMs and he/she will await their decision in the matter.
- 4.13. In case of sub-contracting, the bidder shall take responsibility of the ad option of IP by the sub-contractor.

5. PREVIOUS TRANSGRESSION

- 5.1. The Bidder declares that no previous transgression occurred in the last t hree years immediately before signing of this Integrity Pact, with any oth er company in any country in respect of any corrupt practices envisaged hereunder or with any Public Sector Enterprise in India or any Governme nt Department in India that could justify bidder's exclusion from the tend er process.
- 5.2. If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, Bidder can be di squalified from the tender process or the contract, if already awarded, can be terminated for such reason.

6. COMPANY CODE OF CONDUCT

6.1. Bidders are also advised to have a company code of conduct (clearly rej ecting the use of bribes and other unethical behavior) and a compliance program for the implementation of the code of conduct throughout the c

ompany.

7. SANCTIONS FOR VIOLATION

- 7.1. Any breach of the aforesaid provisions by the Bidder or any one employ ed by him or acting on his behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the Bidder) or the commission of any offence by the Bidder or any one employed by him or acting on his behalf, as defined in Chapter IX of the I ndian Penal Code, 1860 or the Prevention of Corruption Act 1888 or any other act enacted for the prevention of corruption shall entitle the Buyer to take all or any one of the following actions, wherever required:-
- 7.1.1. To immediately call off the pre-contract negotiations without assigning any reason or giving any compensation to the Bidder. However, the proceedings with the other bidder(s) would continue.
- 7.1.2. The Earnest Money / Security Deposit / Performance Bond shall stand fo rfeited either fully or partially, as decided by the Buyer and the Buyer shall not be required to assign any reason therefore.
- 7.1.3. To immediately cancel the contract, if already signed, without giving an y compensation to the Bidder.
- 7.1.4. To recover all sums already paid by the Buyer, and in case of an Indian Bidder with interest thereon at 2% higher than the prevailing Prime Lend ing Rate, while in case of a Bidder from a country other than India with in terest thereon at 2% higher than the LIBOR. If any outstanding payment is due to the Bidder from the Buyer in connection with any other contract for any other defence stores, such outstanding payment could also be ut ilized to recover the aforesaid sum and interest.
- 7.1.5. To encash the advance bank guarantee and performance bond/warrant y bond if furnished by the Bidder, in order to recover the payments, already made by the Buyer, along with interest.
- 7.1.6. To cancel all or any other Contracts with Bidder.
- 7.1.7. To debar the Bidder from entering into any bid from the Government of India for minimum period of five years, which may be further extended a t the discretion of the Buyer.
- 7.1.8. To recover all sums paid in violation of the Pact by Bidder(s) to any mid dleman or agent or broker with a view to securing the contract.
- 7.1.9. If the Bidder or any employee of the Bidder or any person acting on beh alf of the Bidder, either directly or indirectly, is closely related to any of the officers of the Buyer, or alternatively, if any close relative of an officer of the Buyer has financial interest/stake in the Bidder's firm, the same shall be disclosed by the Bidder at the time of filing of tender. Any failure to disclose the interest involved shall entitle the Buyer to rescind the contract without payment of any compensation to the Bidder.
- 7.1.10. The bidder shall not lend to or borrow any money from or enter into any monetary dealings or transactions, directly or indirectly, with any employ ee of the Buyer, and if he does so, the Buyer shall be entitled forthwith to rescind the contract and all other contracts with the Bidder. The Bidder shall be liable to pay compensation for any loss or damage to the Buyer resulting from such rescission and the Buyer shall be entitled to deduct the amount so payable from the money(s) due to the Bidder.
- 7.1.11. In case where irrevocable letters of Credit have been received in respect of any contract signed by the Buyer with the Bidder, the same shall not be opened.
- 7.2. The decision of the Buyer to the effect that a breach of the provisions of th is Integrity Pact has been committed by the Bidder shall be final and bindin

g on the Bidder, however, the Bidder can approach the monitor(s) appointe d for the purposes of this pact.

Note: The term 'close relative' for this purpose would mean spouse whether resid ing with the Government servant or not, but not include a spouse separated fr om the Government servant by a decree or order of the competent court; son or daughter or step son or step daughter and wholly dependent upon Govern ment servant, but does not include a child or step child who no longer in any way dependent upon the Government servant or of whose custody the Govern ment servant has been deprived or by or under any law; any other person related, whether by blood or marriage, to the Government servant or to the Government servant's wife or husband and wholly dependent upon Government servant.

8. EXAMINATION OF BOOKS OF ACCOUNTS

In case of any allegation of violation of any provisions of this Integrity Pact or payment of commission, the Buyer or its agencies shall be entitled to examin e the Books of Accounts of the Bidder and the Bidder shall provide necessary i nformation of the relevant financial documents in English and shall extend all possible help for the purpose of such examination.

9. LAW AND PLACE OF JURISDICTION

This Pact is subject to Indian Law. The place of performance and jurisdiction is the seat of the Buyer i.e. New Delhi.

10. OTHER LEGAL ACTIONS

The actions stipulated in this Integrity Pact are without prejudice to any other legal action that may follow in accordance with the provisions of the extant law in force relating to any civil or criminal proceedings.

11. VALIDITY

11.1. The validity of this Integrity Pact shall be from the date of its signing an d extend upto 5 years or the complete execution of the contract to the s atisfaction of both the Buyer and the Bidder/Seller, whichever is later.
